THINGS TO CONSIDER:

Do you have insurance?

If No: You might want to apply for badgercare. You can call to do this: 888-794-5556 or online. Here is the website: <https://access.wisconsin.gov/access/>

If you want someone to help you apply for Badgercare, contact Health & Human Services in Richland County to do this: 608-647-8821.

If Yes: Continue with contacting a resource that works for you.

Do you have transportation to get to treatment in or outside of Richland County?

- Badgercare will cover MTM medical transportation if you call 48 hours in advance: 866-907-1493.
- Think about who could help get you to appointments.
- Richland Transit Taxi Service: (608) 649-8294; Towne Taxi: (608) 647-3114
- ADRC Public Transportation runs bus routes through the county. Reservations are required at least one business day (24hrs) prior. Call 608-647-4616 for reservations.

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Counseling

Pauquette Center Outpatient Services
608-647-4705, Richland Center, Reedsburg

Offers assessment, referral, and treatment for substance abuse and mental health in Richland County. Most services are covered by private insurance, Medicaid and Medicare. Short and long term recovery counseling one-on-one.

Richland County Health and Human Services,
608-647-8821, Richland Center

Offers assessment, referral, and treatment for substance abuse and mental health for Richland County residents. Most services are covered by private insurance, Medicaid and Medicare, or sliding-scale fees for those without insurance. They support recovery from addiction with short-term services, and long term assistance to those coping with persistent substance abuse issues.

Some programs are full or have requirements that won't work for you. If you hit a roadblock, consider a local resource like Health and Human Services at 608-647-8821.

DAY TREATMENT OUTSIDE RICHLAND:

Tellurian's Day Treatment Program

Patients receive weekly individual therapy alongside daily group sessions and learn essential recovery tools.

UnityPoint Health- Meriter, 608-417-8144
Madison

Their NewStart program provides intensive outpatient treatment for adults and adolescents. Experts develop individual treatment plans for each person and family.

UW Health, 608-282-8270, Madison

Intensive outpatient program that interrupts the addictive process and introduces you to recovery. Offers a day track and an evening track.

Rogers Behavioral Health, 800-767-4411
Madison, Oconomowoc

Intensive outpatient care for 3 hours/day, 5 days/week, 6 to 8 weeks. Care includes addiction treatment and medication-assisted options.

OUTPATIENT:

ASAP (Addiction Services and Pharmacotherapy) 608-807-1428, Madison

Offers outpatient medication-assisted treatment with methadone, suboxone, or vivitrol.

DETOX:
